

## **Directions for La Cardabela, Margon**

### **Directions from Carcassonne airport**

Leave the airport at Carcassonne and follow the blue autoroute signs for the A61. After about 2 kms you arrive at the péage. Once through the péage, you take the A61 southbound, signposted Barcelona. Keep on this autoroute until you reach the point where it joins with the A9 (Languedocienne), and, now ignoring the westbound Barcelona route, you follow the eastbound A9, signposted Montpellier, Nîmes, Lyon...

Pass the Narbonne and then the Béziers turn-offs until you reach sortie (junction) 34, signposted Pézenas, Agde and Vias.

After the péage you enter a roundabout - take care, it can be confusing - take the 2nd exit, signposted Pézenas.

From there simply follow the Pézenas signs, leaving this main road after about 6 km at the first sign for Pézenas (signposted Centre Ville). Do not take the route that continues and goes over a flyover.

(If you do, all is not lost, but come off at the next junction marked Pézenas Nord, then you should go to along to the traffic lights at the edge of the town centre, turn left and then got to para 2 of Directions from the North.)

Then follow directions below marked "The last bit..."

### **Directions from Montpellier airport**

As you leave the car parking area you approach a roundabout that goes under an overpass. Enter the roundabout and take the first exit, signposted A9, Nîmes, Lyon, Barcelona.

You go up a ramp onto the overpass. Keep on this road, leaving when you see the sign A9 Barcelona. Ignore the Nîmes / Lyon exits. They are eastbound whereas you are going to travel on the A9 westbound.

Eventually you reach a large roundabout, and again, take the exit A9 Barcelona.

After a few kilometres you will go through a péage. Take a ticket and keep it. You pay when you leave the autoroute.

Keep on the A9, following signs for Barcelona. Travel westbound until you reach sortie 34, (50 kms from the Montpellier junction). This is signposted Pézenas, Agde and Vias.

This is where you pay. After the péage you enter a large roundabout - take care, it can be confusing - take the 2nd exit, signposted Pézenas.

From there simply follow the Pézenas signs, leaving this main road after about 6 km at the first sign for Pézenas (signposted Centre Ville). Do not take the route that continues and goes over a flyover.

(If you do, all is not lost, but come off at the next junction marked Pézenas Nord, then you should go to along to the traffic lights at the edge of the town centre, turn left and then got to para 2 of Directions from the North.)

Then follow directions below marked "The last bit..."

## **Directions from the north**

You will take the A75 (there is only one route) travelling due south, over the mountains and via Millau. This bit is exciting as you go over the highest bridge in the world, the Millau viaduct, designed by Lord Norman Foster. Keep on the A75 until you leave the A75 at Pézenas, and follow signs for Centre Ville. Take this main road through the town centre (it's not so big) and follow signs for Béziers, Bedariuex and Roujan.

Passing the large Champion supermarket on your right until you arrive at a large roundabout (there are two large car sales garages there). This is signposted A9 and Agde to the left, Béziers straight on and, the route you want, Bedariuex and Roujan, to the right. Now, below, "Follow this route to Roujan..."

## **The Last bit...**

At 1 km there is the Pézenas town sign, and 500 metres later a large roundabout. First exit right is Pézenas town, second exit - the one to take, is signposted Bedariuex, Roujan.

Follow this route to Roujan, going straight on, past GEDIMAT builders merchants and Aldi store on the right, over two more roundabouts in quick succession, first passing the Intermarche and then the Fire Station on the left, still following the Roujan signs. At this point you are about 8 kms from us.

The last stage is to travel down the old Roman road, a typical south of France tree lined route which will take you into Roujan.

Driving slowly you soon reach the Hotel de Ville (Mairie) on your left. Take the road at the side of the hotel de Ville - a small road, signposted Margon.

You can now start using the map below for the last 2 kilometres.
